



# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### **BETWEEN**

#### **CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY**

## **AND**

#### DALIAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

Chiang Mai University in Thailand and Dalian University of Technology in China agree to enter into the following terms of agreement with respect to furthering scholarly and educational exchanges.

- 1. Both universities agree to cooperate in a spirit of mutual understanding and goodwill and to strengthen their ties of friendship.
- 2. Through close mutual cooperation, both universities shall engage in the exchange of faculty, researchers and students, as well as scholarly publications. They shall, furthermore, act to develop joint research projects and in other ways to promote a broad range of scholarly and educational exchanges.
- 3. This MOU does not include any immediate funding; however, both universities shall support their joint programs, whenever it is feasible. In general, each party shall bear the cost of its participation in projects and activities unless otherwise agreed.
- 4. Implementation of this MOU shall be discussed and agreed upon by both universities. If necessary, a memorandum on its implementation shall be made by the appropriate representatives of both universities.
- 5. Through these activities, both universities shall promote friendship and goodwill between Thailand and China and shall contribute to the academic and cultural benefit of both nations.

- 6. This MOU shall become effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing. The agreed-upon period may be further extended by subsequent agreements in writing made before it expires.
- 7. This MOU may be terminated upon six (6) month's prior written notice without cause by either the university. In such a case, the programs or activities already approved by both universities shall be allowed to be completed under the conditions of this MOU.
- 8. Either university shall use the name, official emblem, logo, trade mark (or any variation thereof) or other intellectual property belonging to the other university on any publication, document, paper, audio or visual presentation, or for publicity purposes, with the prior written consent of the other university.

There are two signed copies of this MOU in English and each party to the MOU will retain one copy.
