



AGREEMENT

between

UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG, Australia

and

CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, Thailand

concerning

Participation in the University of Wollongong Study Abroad Program

Noting the agreement for educational co-operation between the University of Wollongong and Chiang Mai University, the purpose of this agreement is to establish conditions under which students of Chiang Mai University can participate in Study Abroad opportunities at the University of Wollongong.

- 1. Study Abroad at the University of Wollongong will be open to undergraduate or postgraduate students who have at least a 'B' average in their studies at Chiang Mai University.
- Chiang Mai University students will apply for the University of Wollongong Study Abroad
 program through the International Education Office, which will handle the application process
 and communications with the University of Wollongong.
- 3. The University of Wollongong will provide the International Education Office with a listing of courses to be offered each semester prior to the start of the semester so that Chiang Mai students can select their courses prior to departure.
- 4. The University of Wollongong will issue an official transcript to visiting Chiang Mai University students indicating courses taken and grades received.
- 5. Chiang Mai University will accept the University of Wollongong's courses for transfer of credit.
- 6. Students participating in the Study Abroad Program are responsible for payment of all compulsory charges, including the Study Abroad tuition fee, University fees, Overseas Student Health Cover, as well as all travel, accommodation and other personal expenses.

The term of this agreement shall commence on the date it is accepted by both parties and shall continue indefinitely. Either party may terminate this agreement by providing the other party with at least 90 days' prior written notice. This agreement may only be altered or amended by the written agreement of both parties.
