



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY

AND

COLLEGE OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, CAN THO UNIVERSITY

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “MOA”) is made and entered into on 11 April, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as “Effective Date”) by and between:

Faculty of Science, Chiang Mai University (hereinafter referred to as “FoS-CMU”), represented by Prof. Dr. Torranin Chairuangri, Dean of the Faculty of Science, Chiang Mai University, located at 239 Huaykaew Road A. Muang, Chiang Mai 50200, Thailand,

and

College of Environment and Natural Resources, Can Tho University (hereinafter referred to as “CENRes-CTU”), represented by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nguyen Van Cong, Dean of the College of Environment and Natural Resources, Can Tho University, located at Campus II, 3/2 Street, Xuan Khanh ward, Ninh Kieu District, Can Tho City, Viet Nam.

1. Purpose and Scope of Cooperation

FoS-CMU and CENRes-CTU hereby agree to encourage and promote academic cooperation between their two respective parties. Subject to mutual consent, areas of cooperation and activities include:

1.1 Visits by faculty members and students from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research and other educational activities.

1.2 Admission of qualified students from one university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in undergraduate and graduate programs, or participating in research.

1.3 Exchange of academic information through seminars, academic conferences, and academic publications.

1.4 The promotion of other academic activities in order to support the above mentioned goals.

2. Implementation and Funding

To implement the collaborative activities envisaged, representatives of **FoS-CMU** and **CENRes-CTU** may propose, negotiate and conclude specific agreements. Details, including financial arrangements, will be set out in said agreements. **FoS-CMU** and **CENRes-CTU** acknowledge that in the absence of any provision to the contrary in the specific agreement(s), all expenses of salary, travel, accommodation, living and other related costs will be the responsibility of the visitor's home university.

3. Confidentiality and Ownership of Intellectual Property

The two parties agree that in the event of research collaboration involving confidential information and leading to intellectual property rights, further agreement must be negotiated in each case in accordance with the policies of the two parties.

4. Amendment and Termination

4.1 This **MOA** becomes effective on the day it is signed and remains valid for five (5) years. Each party may terminate the **MOA** at anytime by notifying the other party of its intent to do so in writing at least six months in advance. Projects in progress at the time of **MOA** expiration or termination, as well as obligations relating to confidentiality and intellectual property stated in Section 3, will remain unaffected.

4.2 Amendment or modification of the **MOA** content stated herewith can only occur after both parties discuss and create an appropriate supplementary agreement executed using the same formalities as this **MOA**.

5. Settlement of Disputes Law

The settlement of possible disputes between the parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation of this **MOA** shall be negotiated in good faith to solve problems that arise.

This **MOA** is drawn up in English in two (2) copies and each party shall retain one original each.
