

Memorandum of Understanding
between
The University of Wisconsin – Green Bay
and
Chiang Mai University

The Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System d.b.a. the University of Wisconsin – Green Bay and Chiang Mai University, Thailand confirm a willingness to advance educational and cultural cooperation between the two institutions by forming this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). This agreement permits the institutions to establish activities such as those listed below.

- Degree Partnership Programs (2+2, 2+1, joint degree);
- The exchange of students (graduate and undergraduate);
- The exchange of University faculty, researchers, and staff for research, teaching, and/or community service projects;
- Online collaboration among courses;
- Faculty Research collaborations and Graduate students Research Collaboration
- Joint conferences, performances, meetings, seminars, and workshops;
- The exchange of information and publications, and
- Other activities mutually agreed upon by the two institutions.

Prior to entering into any of the activities outlined above, conditions of activities shall be specified in written sub-agreements and secure approval from University administrative officers. It is understood that this Memorandum of Understanding does not in any way diminish the full autonomy of either University, nor establish financial obligations.

This agreement shall become effective on the date of signature by representatives of the two institutions, and will remain effective for a period of five years. The period of validity may be extended upon mutual agreement of the two institutions.

This MOU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party. Any termination will not affect ongoing activities.
